

ACODO Photographic Policy

Throughout the world copyright infringement occurs. The aim of the ACODO Photographic Policy is to protect ACODO and the rights of all the ACODO children.

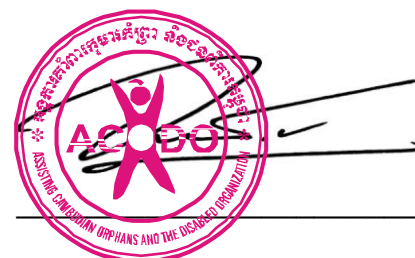
For the purposes of the ACODO Photographic Policy the term "ACODO Associates" is taken to mean all ACODO staff, ACODO contractors, partner organization members, ACODO volunteers, sponsors and visitors.

For the purposes of the ACODO Photographic Policy the term "image" refers to all digital and non-digital photographs, movies, sound clips and other images taken by any means.

The following regulations must be followed at all times:

1. The informed consent of senior ACODO staff should always be obtained before an image is taken and its intended use(s) explained. Where possible, the child should be shown the finished product.
2. ACODO Associates are invited to take images of the children whilst they are performing their traditional dance and music show.
3. All images taken by ACODO Associates must be strictly for their personal use.
4. No images of the ACODO premises or children may be sold or reproduced for any commercial or charitable purpose.
5. ACODO Associates who wish to use images of the ACODO premises or children for fund raising purposes must gain written permission from ACODO before proceeding.
6. All images should protect the privacy and dignity of the children.
7. ACODO Associates are not permitted to take any images of the children's sleeping area, washing or bathroom facilities.
8. Children should be adequately clothed in all images.
9. No sexually suggestive images of the children, or those that could be interpreted as such, can be taken.
10. The real names of all the vulnerable children should be changed and it should be indicated that they have been changed.
11. All ACODO Associates must immediately and permanently delete any image that accidentally contravenes the ACODO Photographic Policy.
